TEACHER SCHOLARSHIP FOR EDUCATION MAJOR

Purpose: The purpose of the Henry County Retired Educators Association Scholarship is to assist the advanced student seeking an Initial Teacher Certification. The student applicant should display a sincere interest in becoming an educator in the Henry County School System. Excluded are those individuals already with probationary certification and eligible for state and system sponsored staff development courses leading to full certification or renewals of certification.

Applicants: The applicant must -

- 1. Be a resident of Henry County
- 2. Be currently enrolled in an approved program leading to Initial Teacher Certification.
- 3. Have demonstrated teaching potential.
- 4. Be interested in teaching in Henry County Schools.
- 5. Be within two (2) years or 64 semester hours of initial certification (be a junior or senior in good standing).

Those Encouraged to apply:

- 1. Paraprofessionals with current or past service.
- 2. Substitute teachers.
- 3. Other non-certified personnel employed by the Henry County Board of Education.
- Henry County college students, currently at the junior or senior class level, who are completing a planned program leading to initial teacher certification within two (2) years or 64 semester hours.

Timeframe for Use:

The scholarship is available for use during the summer session following selection, the academic year which follows and/or the summer following that academic year. Scholarship funds not utilized during the time designated shall be voided and remain in the general scholarship account.

The treasurer of the Henry County Retired Educators Association may issue scholarship funds approved yearly with a minimum of \$500.00 and up to a maximum of \$750.00 per scholarship. The amount and number of scholarships available will be determined by the funds available and the pleasure of the HCREA.

Scholarship recipients are eligible to reapply for future scholarship consideration.

The decision of the Scholarship Committee shall be final.
